# **Lunch Meeting**



On August 25<sup>th</sup> we had a guest speaker during our Zoomy Zoom lunch meeting. Leslie Lawrence the Food Truck Program Manager for Sensable Snacks.

Easterseals UCP and Trillium Health Resources are working together with area food banks to help teens and young adults with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD). Individuals between the ages of 16-26 will develop employment skills to work on food trucks that serve healthy snacks throughout the communities of New Bern and Ahoskie, North Carolina.

Individuals start out as Volunteers. If they are a fit and are able to pick up the work they are given internships. After working for some time as an interm and picking up more they can transition into paid employment. They learn order taking, inventory, working face to face with customers.

Due to Covid their trucks are not up and running at this time. You may go to Easter Seals on Trent Road and see their truck parked in the parking lot if you would like to see it. At this time they are selling Snack-o-grams on their virtual store. A package will be mailed with a T-shirt(Child or Adult), snacks and a personal card. These boxes are being packed at home so this keeps the workers employed. You shop and pay online, the staff will pack the box and then it will be sent via the post office. 
