DID YOU KNOW?

1917: The original Civitan emblem was simple, with "Civitan Club" on a triangular field.

Designed by the founding members of Civitan, emblem originally represented Birmingham club, then was adopted by other clubs as Civitan spread across the United States. In 1920, with the addition of Canada to the Civitan family of nations, the "International Association" band was added.

This emblem was featured on the cover of the first issue of Civitan Magazine, published in July 1922.


