Clergy Appreciation Breakfast

Once again Tryon and New Bern Civitan Clubs joined together to honor the Clergy of our Community for all that they do. We had a wonderful celebration of our clergy on Tuesday February 11th at the United Methodist Church Auditorium. Cammie Armstrong and Jan Snyder from New Bern Civitan Club did a lovely job of putting this event together. The ladies told the story behind why we honor the Clergy during one week of February. They then handed out a Certificate of Appreciation to each clergy member present.

Clergy Appreciation Week is an international project of Civitan International, which honors local leaders of all faiths for their dedicated service to their local communities. Since 1963, Civitan clubs around the world have set aside a week in February of each year to honor local faith leaders for their acts of service.

The project was inspired by the story of the Four Chaplains. On February 3, 1943, four military chaplains—a Methodist minister, a Catholic priest, a Reformed minister and a Jewish rabbi—sacrificed their lives in service to others on board the USS Dorchester. The troop transport ship, in route to Greenland, was hit by a torpedo. The four chaplains, George L. Fox, Alexander D. Goode, John P. Washington, and Clark V. Poling, removed their own life jackets to give to other passengers and locked arms in prayer for the safety of others as the ship submerged into the icy waters.

YMCA Water Safety

The TWIN RIVERS YMCA teaches over 2,400 children water safety education and swim instruction each year. Volunteers help make this life-saving program possible. You can help. Volunteers will assist 4th grade students learn how to properly wear life jackets, practice saving a drowning victim, and learn to float and keep their heads above water. To ensure they meet the highest standard in safety, 15 volunteers per day are needed for Water Safety.

Water Safety takes place in the Outdoor Pool, Tuesdays 10am – 12noon, Wednesdays 9am – 11am Thursdays 10am – 12noon Through the month of March and the 1st 2 days of April.

We have been helping out with this program for a few years now. If you aren't a swimmer or you don't want to go in the water volunteers are needed to be on dry deck as well.
