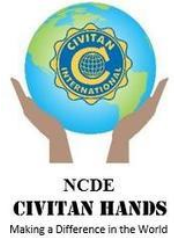

CLERGY APPRECIATION LUNCHEON: February 7th Submitted by Juliet Meyer

Tryon Civitan teamed up with New Bern Civitan to honor local clergy during Clergy Appreciation Week on February 7th. Juliet Meyer (Tryon Club) and Chris Kelso (New Bern Club) co-chaired the event. It was held at Centenary Methodist Church where guests enjoyed a great meal along with fellowship. Paul Saik, Centenary UMC Minister of Music, provided the entertainment. The program was provided by Rev. John Robinson, the interim Pastor of Neuse Forest Presbyterian Church and Chairman of the Craven Co. Disaster Relief Alliance (CCDRA). The subject was The Neuse Forest Presbyterian Church turning the Educational Building into a full time Volunteer Hosting Site for work teams coming to New Bern to help the community rebuild and the relief going on after Hurricane Florence. Leigh Wilkinson read the Clergy Appreciation Week Proclamation by New Bern Mayor Dana Outlaw.

Clergy Appreciation Week began as a commemoration of the death of four military chaplains (George L. Fox, Alexander D. Goode, John P. Washington, Clark V. Poling) during World War II who were aboard the troopship, the USS Dorchester. The ship was torpedoed in the North Atlantic and the chaplains helped to quiet the soldiers, finally giving their lives when they gave their life jackets to soldiers. This time is set aside each year to remember this heroic deed and pay tribute to all clergy who dedicate themselves to making this a better world. Appreciation Certificates were given to the Clergy who were present.
